Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Do you know anyone who is sincere about their religion, but they are wrong? Or do you know someone who works tirelessly to be a good person so that they will be considered worthy to go to heaven? Have you ever thought about talking with them about the simplicity of the gospel?

Digging Deeper

What is regeneration (John 3:3; 1 Peter 1:23; Titus 3:5)? What does it mean that you become a new creation and that you trade your old self for your new self? What changed inside you when you are born again?

Study the power of God's hand (Ezekiel 8:3; Psalm 16:11; 18:35; 89:13; 144:7; Isaiah 31:3; 49:16; 59:1; Jeremiah 15:6; Acts 4:30; 11:21; Hebrews 10:31; Joshua 4:24; Exodus 15:6; Luke 1:66; 1 Peter 5:6). Have you sensed God's outstretched hands protecting you or overwhelming you with His love?

Meditate upon these five aspects of sharing the good news of Jesus Christ: shine (Matthew 5:14-16); make disciples (28:19); preach the gospel (Mark 16:15); go out and compel (Luke 14:23); have compassion and rescue (Jude 1:22-23). Are you active in all of these, none of these, or some of them? What can you do in order to heighten your compassion for the lost?

Applying the Word to Life

What can you do in your every day life to live under the lordship of Jesus Christ? Are you walking Jesus' path, or are you selfishly living the way you want?

If you have stopped sharing your faith, then start again by praying for someone you know who is lost. Ask God to open up a door for you to start speaking about spiritual things.
