Discussion Questions

Getting Started

1. Are you able to discern the voices you hear all around you? Can you tell when Satan (and his demons) are lying to you? Are you able to see when the ways of the world are detrimental to you? Do you have the wisdom to say “no” to your flesh? Are you careful to not hang out with those who pull you down?

Digging Deeper

2. Read about the voice of God. God’s voice is not just a still small voice (1 Kings 19:12), but it can also sound as mighty as thunder (Ps 29:3-9; 68:33; Job 37:5; Ez 43:2; Rev 1:15; Jer 10:13).
3. Jesus is the door by which we find salvation and security (John 10:7; 14:6). Are you staying on the correct side of the door, or do you some times leave God’s protection for “the world”?
4. Who wouldn’t want to listen to the voice of someone who is willing to die for them? Do you trust Jesus with your life?
5. God warns us about being friends with the world (James 4:4; Rom 12:2; 1 John 2:15; John 15:19; 2 Tim 4:10; 2 Cor 6:14; Eph 2:1-2). Who gives you the strength to withstand the temptations of this world? How does He empower you?

6. On a scale of 1-10, how closely are you walking with God? Be brutally honest with yourself. What needs to change in your life if this number is lower than you know it should be? What will you do to take a step closer to God’s heart?
7. Are you allowing Jesus to guide you towards the life He wants you to live? How fulfilled are you in your job, school, love-life, friendships? In stead of jumping from one pasture to another, how can you grow green grass right under your feet?
